

Whare Ranginui Healing Centre

Not far up Graham Valley Road, in a room filled with light and warmth, Sylvia Geddes practices the healing modalities of Reiki, AromaTouch and Past Life Regressions. This is the Whare Ranginui Healing Centre which Sylvia established 20 years ago.

Sylvia was first introduced to Reiki by a friend in Germany. Curious to learn more, Sylvia did her full training when she came to New Zealand 25 years ago:

"I was inquisitive and I never looked back. I didn't feel anything when I did the course at first but then I did. I had to learn to trust, and I do trust." Sylvia says.

Originating in Japan in the early 1920s from the teachings of Mikao Usui, Reiki - **rei** meaning universal spirit, **ki** meaning vital life force or energy - is a healing technique:

"I'm channelling the universal energy above like a conduit or bridge to get the energy to the living being, to where it is needed. People come for emotional or physical issues, for Body, Soul and Mind, you can't isolate it. You can't just say, for example, I've got stomach ache...you have to look at why the person got stomach ache. There's always an emotional background." Sylvia explains.

"I work through the Chakras, starting at the head and ending at the feet for grounding. I don't touch the head but work in the aura around the head. I have my hands slightly on the body."

As Sylvia explains she doesn't have a magic wand:

"...people must be prepared to do the emotional work behind whatever issues they have, take responsibility for their lives and take charge of whatever is going on in their lives. The energy comes in to help you to make the decision to get the body, soul and mind into alignment and blossom. See your inner beauty, your uniqueness, your perfection if you like.". A Reiki session takes an hour for the hands-on:

"...with a little bit of chat beforehand and then discussion after. I don't have a time limit, I promised myself I wouldn't do that. If some people take two hours or longer then that's fine."

Animals - cats, dogs and horses - can benefit also from Reiki. For a Reiki session, Sylvia will see animals at their home.

Sylvia is also practised in AromaTouch, a technique using a massage blend of DoTerra oils:



"There are eight different oils applied on the back and two on the feet. They are for balancing, strengthening the immune system, for any inflammation, or for haemeostasis which is getting all the good cells in your body working and eliminating the bad ones. To help with autonomic imbalance."

"It is massage-like, I use only a gentle touch"

Through the deaths of two husbands, friends and family over her life, Sylvia has had many experiences of grief. From these experiences, Sylvia feels able to offer spiritual grief counselling at the centre also. She stresses that she's not an "official counsellor" but counsels "...in an intuitive or spiritual way."

Although she advertises in our local MVA newsletter, Sylvia believes that word-of-mouth is the best form of advertising for her work:

"It's good to hear about it from a friend. You need to hear from a friend that: I tried this and it worked for me, so you can try it...", Sylvia says.

Having studied the work of Dr. Brian Weiss, an American Psychiatrist, Sylvia uses his methods of Past Life regression. Sylvia considers that Weiss brought Past Life Regression therapy to the

average household. Sylvia also recommends the work of Edward Cayce and Louise Hay.

At the centre, Sylvia offers either a short or long session which can take from two to four hours. Sylvia recommends doing a short session of an hour to start with:

"It's like a meditation", she explains, "and most people are quite comfortable lying on the table...Going back into a previous life, you can see where your original problem or fear comes from. For a simple example - a phobia of spiders, or you are allergic to something or you have one cancer after another. It might be relationship problem which comes from a relationship in a past life..."

"It really depends on how open you are. By letting things go your life can blossom and shine, and become more balanced."

Great Taste Trail - Update

Following completion of the Great Taste Cycle Trail from Kohatu to Tapawera in December last year, the Nelson Tasman Cycle Trails Trust has been continuing work on development of the next section of trail from Tapawera to Ngatimoti. The overall stage has been approved and co-funded by the Ministry of Business Innovation and Employment, and Tasman District Council.

The general route is via the Tapawera-Baton Road, over Baton Saddle, to a new cycle bridge over the Baton River, before proceeding down Baton Road to Woodstock, and then through to Ngatimoti. There are many variables and considerations, and when each stage is approved for funding it is a concept only. The task is then to establish and build a trail within the fixed budget that has been provided, that takes into account land access, construction cost and feasibility, long term flood resilience, environmental impact, and engineering approvals. Work to determine the exact alignment is therefore ongoing at present.

There is no fixed or preferred route but a desire to create an attractive trail that is safe for users and that benefits the communities through increased connectivity.

The Trust is aiming to have a route open in late 2021 for the summer season of cycling.






