HARVEST BBQ WITH THE MOTUEKA GREENS

Do you ever wonder how to use the zucchini that turned into a marrow overnight? Or what different dishes you can prepare with the abundance of vegetables and fruit in your late summer garden? The 'Motueka Greens' Harvest BBQ on March 25th may be just what you're looking for-it will feature vegetable and fruit kebabs, grills, and salads using the summer harvest from our own gardens. Although 'harvest' will be the predominant feature of the BBQ, sausages (provided) and meat (BYO) are also welcome.

The harvest aspect of the BBQ will give the Greens and supporters the chance to help create a delicious vegetarian BBQ using vegetables and/or fruit from their own garden. We'll collaborate and share ideas and explore combinations of fruit, veg, marinades and dressings to produce some interesting kebabs and Grills.

The BBQ, open to Green party members and supporters, will be at the Ngatimoti Community Hall and Reserve (next to the school), on Saturday March 25th, from 5-9pm. From here we ship e-waste to E-Cycle, a Christchurch company, who dismantle the items and recycle as much as possible here in New Zealand.

So please visit our new centre and bring your old computers,tv's, mice, sterios, mobile phones, and almost anything with a plug. There is a charge because we have to ship the items to Christchurch and pay E-Cycle to recycle them




