Being injured is a pain in the ...

Are you injured or bothered by a recurring niggle? I'm Ben Plows-Kolff from Motueka Valley Physiotherapy & Massage located on West Bank Road. Wherever you've got pain, I'd love to help!



I've been living in the valley on and off for the past ten years and, more permanently for the past two. Working at private clinics in Dunedin and Christchurch for five years – as well as observing in other clinics - has raised my awareness of how our current medical model and top-down approach to rehabilitation undermine our intentions to support and nourish people back to wellness and independence.

This awareness has inspired me to practice in a way that empowers, supports and inspires every person I see. Some of the strategies I use to support this intention include: listening and communicating in way that builds trust and safety in our interaction; clearly and openly sharing my knowledge; offering tools (such as exercises) that

support self-sufficiency and independence; offering hands-on treatment that supports recovery and nourishes the body without creating dependence; using a space that supports care, comfort, trust and warmth.

Being at work during the day can be a barrier to seeing a physiotherapist. I want to make my services accessible to everyone in the valley and am open to considering appointments outside of work hours (including weekends) where no other option is possible. 


