CLIMATE CHANGE RISK ASSESSMENT HUI 11-9-23

I attended the 3hr hui hosted by TDC, NCC, Urban Intelligence, & Resilient Organisations. The purpose was to get input from a number of representatives from local community groups. We focussed on the Human Domain which covers skills, knowledge, physical & mental health, norms & institutions of society, customs & culturally significant buildings.

After much discussion we were asked to rank the possible impact of climate change in 2030, 2070, & 2130. on 11 ~~as~~ issues e.g.

- Risk to social cohesion & community wellbeing
- Risk to physical health
- Risk to accessing medical care & emergency services
- Risk to accessing food
- Risk to communications
- Risk to homes & personal assets

The information gathered is to be used by TDC & NCC in their planning for future weather related events & emergencies.
